



Leon County Virtual School – FAQ

General Questions

What grades are served by LCVS?

Grades K-12 are served by LCVS.

What is the difference between FLVS and LCVS?

LCVS teachers are local teachers employed by Leon County Schools. With LCVS all funding stays in Leon County Schools

Are students required to log on at specific times each day?

No, students received their work for the week on Mondays and the work is due on Sundays. Students are required to follow the pacing guide; K-5 4% of the class per week and 6-12 6% of the class per week.

Will LCVS students have access to Classlink?

LCVS students will have access to Classlink and the district resources provided through the platform.

Will students be provided any live instruction?

Students in K-5 are provided live instruction two times per week via Zoom.

Will LCVS students be given a Chromebook to use at home?

Yes, each student will have a Chromebook checked out to them for use during the school year.

How are students graded in virtual school?

Students receive credit and are awarded a grade upon completion of a course segment. Students will receive report cards at the end of each semester; two report cards total for the year.

What is a DBA?

A DBA is a Discussion Based Assessment that is a required part of the coursework. These discussions occur with the teacher via phone or Zoom and assess what a student has learned in a learning module.

Will parents have access to student grades and progress?

Each parent will setup up a parent/guardian account where they can monitor student progress and grades.

How do students get additional help in classes if needed?

Our teachers provide tutoring sessions. Students can sign up for these sessions with their teacher as needed.

Do LCVS students have to participate in standardized testing?

Yes, students in grades 3-11 participate in the Florida Standards Assessment. Students are also required to take End Of Course exams for Biology, Algebra, geometry, Us History, and Civics.

Can you child work ahead and accelerate?

Yes, students can work ahead and accelerate their learning.

Grades K-5 Specific Questions

As an elementary student what electives can I take?

Elementary students can choose two electives from Intro to Spanish, STEM, Reading, Functional Basic Skills in Communications, and PE.

Do elementary students still take district progress monitoring assessments?

Yes, students still participate in STAR Reading and Math as well as iReady multiple times throughout the school year.

Grades 6-12 Specific Questions

Can my child play sports at their home zone school?

Yes, students can play sports at their home zone school. You would need to reach out to the athletic director at that school for more information.

Will my student earn a high school diploma?

Yes, LCVS seniors are awarded a diploma and coursework is accepted by Bright Futures.

Can students Dual Enroll?

Yes, juniors and seniors can dual enroll with TCC or Lively.

Can students take AP classes?

Yes, students can take AP classes and the AP exams.

Can students in grades 6th-12th receive additional help with coursework?

Yes, students in grades 6th – 12th can take part in open “free” tutoring. Students can setup appointments with their teachers during open tutoring sessions. Secondary teachers also offer group Zoom sessions.
